Year 12 - 2015 Results

The staff of Nagle Catholic College strives earnestly to assist students to achieve their best possible academic results. As part of the Reflective Practice process, an analysis of Year12 Results is conducted every year and forms the basis of any change to teaching practices from Year 7 – 12.

The Schools Curriculum and Standards Authority, the Tertiary Information Services Centre and the Catholic Education Office make a wide range of data and statistics available. Nagle Catholic College also collates its own data.

The following sets of data are those considered to be the most useful in providing feedback to the College community.

Achievement of WACE

The achievement of The West Australian Certificate of Education (WACE) is an important base level of achievement for all students. It is also a requirement for entry into university. The percentage of Nagle Catholic College Year 12 students achieving their WACE is displayed.

Triciles

The Triciles are determined by ranking all students by their ATAR and dividing the group into three sections – Low ATAR group, Mid ATAR group and High ATAR group. An average school would have 33% of their students in each of the triciles. The percentage of Nagle Catholic College students in each tricile is shown.
