## EVANGELISATION PLAN 2022 - 2025

### Christian Witness (Feeling the nature of Jesus)

#### Presence

The life and teachings of Jesus present in the College.

#### Charity

The work and impact of Jesus on the lives of people in the College.

#### Focus On

- Prayer
- The Eucharist

#### Focus On

- Christian Service Learning (CSL)
- A charity plan for the College

#### Strategies

- Grow and create a Prayer space. In each Home Room which becomes the focal point of Prayer life.
- Support students and staff to gather formally for weekly Prayer as a Home Room on Fridays, reflecting on the coming Sunday's Gospel.
- Support students and staff in growing their capacity to write the Home Room Prayer by providing them with resources.
- Invite students and staff to celebrate the Eucharist in House groups during Pastoral Care Periods (PCP) and as Year groups on Retreat.

#### Strategies

- Integrate project based/inquiry learning into Religion that leads into Christian Service Learning.
- Launch of Nagle Care - SCSA Endorsed Program (Years 10 - 12) that embeds service learning as part of a pathway toward graduation.
- Create a social justice group among staff with the aim of engaging in service while providing opportunities for students to become involved.
- Develop and design a College charity plan that encompasses the four pillars of charity.
- Offer an immersion experience for students to put charity into action.

### Ministry of the Word (Knowing the nature of Jesus)

#### Catechesis

Experiences intended to help the College come to know Jesus.

#### Knowledge and Experience

Learning intended to help the College come to know about Jesus.

#### Focus On

- The Retreat Program
- The Parish and College relationship

#### Focus On

- Staff faith formation opportunities
- Accreditation pathways to promote formation

#### Strategies

- Tether the Retreat themes to the College's Vision for Learning.
- Involve the Directors of Students for each Year group in the design and implementation of the Retreats.
- Grow the capacity of staff to facilitate Retreats and be a part of the Retreat experience.
- Commence a regular Parish-College community meeting.
- Generate opportunities for students and staff to engage in Parish events and functional agencies.

#### Strategies

- Create a Staff Retreat experience.
- Provide a Staff Pilgrimage.
- Ensure whole staff Faith and Life meetings have clear objectives and develop faith formation.
- Promote faith formation through individualised accreditation plans.
